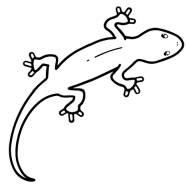

Stay tuned for all the fun ahead!



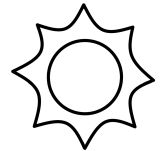
SUMMER CAMP 2025:
